

Indonesia IFLI-SEASSI (Summer) Academic Notes

The Academic Program Upon arrival to the Southeast Asian Studies Summer Institute (SEASSI) program, you will be placed in the appropriate language level for Indonesian for the summer term. The program is hosted at the University of Wisconsin - Madison by the Wisconsin Intensive Summer Language Institutes (WISLI).

Courses You will take two courses in the language sequence, each 4-credits, while in Madison's SEASSI program. You will receive 8 credits in total. See below for the UW-Madison language sequence:

Second Semester	ASIALANG 308
Third Semester	ASIALANG 407
Fourth Semester	ASIALANG 408
Fifth Semester	ASIALANG 507
Sixth Semester	ASIALANG 508

Eighth Semester	ASIALANG 608

Note These are all topics courses, ex. ASIALANG 307 = First Semester Southeast Asian Language (topic: First Semester Indonesian).

ADDITIONALLY Summer course numbers will show as higher level courses (ex. 300 level course) than those during the fall semester abroad (ex. 200 level course) in your final transcripts. Because courses during the summer are administered and structured differently, a student who may take First and Second Semester Indonesian during the summer would receive credit for ASIALANG 307 & 308, while during the fall they would receive 200-level credits for Third and Fourth Semester Indonesian. This varying course number system applies to all levels of Indonesian. Please refer to the study abroad academic notes for more details.
