## IAP Academic Notes

### Courses

After completing two language courses during the summer SEASSI program, you will take two 4-credit language courses while abroad on the American Councils program. For the fall semester, you will take the next two courses in the language sequence. You will also receive a 4 credit readings course on your transcript. This amounts to a total of 12 credits for the fall semester. See below for the UW-Madison language sequence:

Seventh semester	ASIALANG 421
Eighth semester	ASIALANG 422

For the Reading course that you will take abroad, you will receive one of the following equivalents based on your language level:

Levels	UW Equivalent
Intermediate	ASIALANG 360
Intermediate High	ASIALANG 460
Advanced	ASIALANG 560

If you feel you should receive courses other than the sequenced courses above, please contact your Study Abroad Advisor.

Your fall semester courses will be sent to IAP on an American Councils transcript. IAP will process these courses to a UW-Madison transcript with credit, grades and the course equivalents as listed above. For non-UW-Madison students, you can [order a transcript](#) sent to your home institution.
